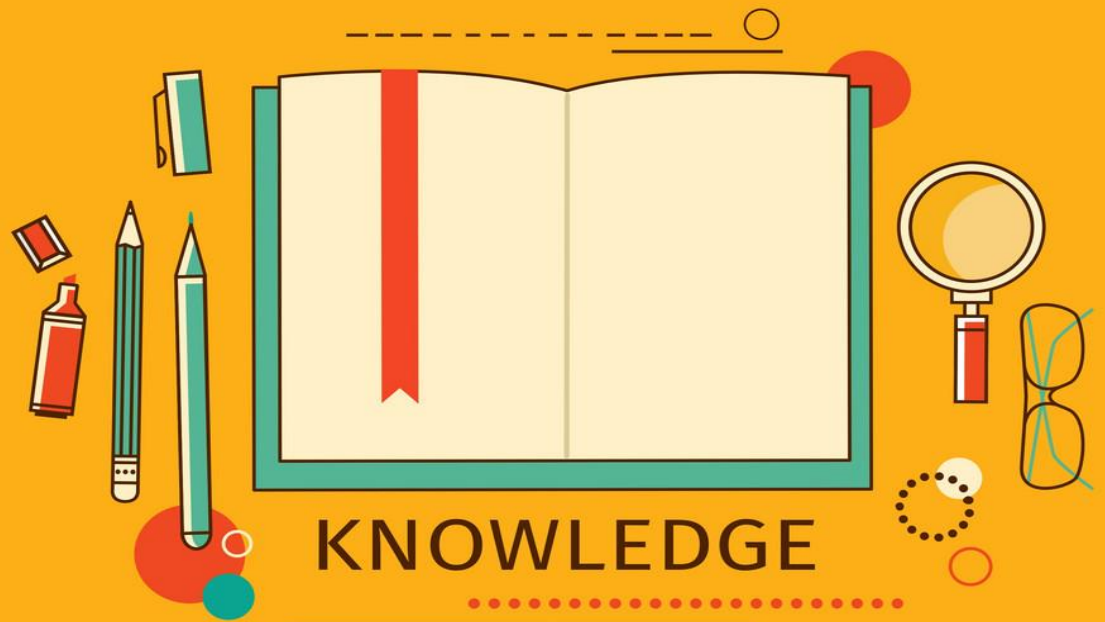



Deuteronomy 6:22


**Again, God is telling you and I

protected you**

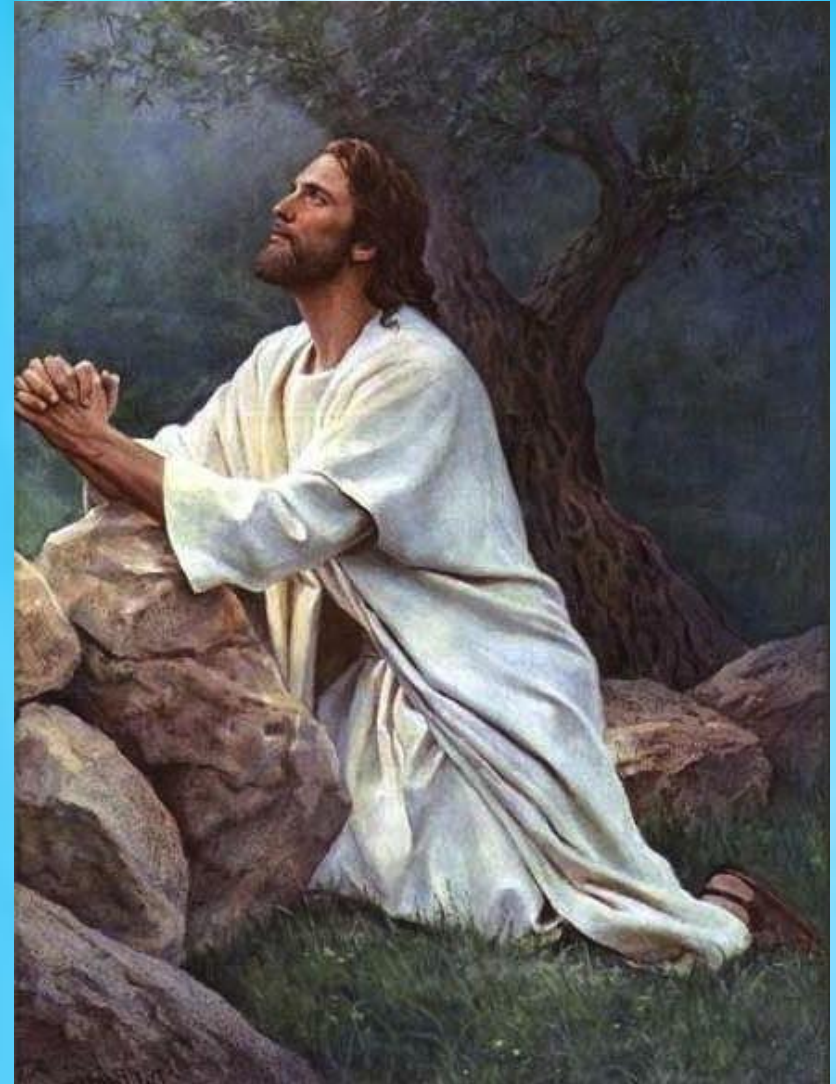


