#### 2 Chronicles Chapter 20



# King Jehoshaphat GOD IS IN CONTROL

### **1. Identify Your ENEMY**

After this, the Moabites and Ammonites with some of the **Meunites came to wage war** against Jehoshaphat. Some people came and told Jehoshaphat, "A vast army is coming against you from Edom, from the other side of the Dead Sea. It is already in Hazezon Tamar" (that is, En Gedi).

# "Alarmed..." (NIV) or "Jehoshaphat was afraid.." (NASB)



# 2. Don't Be Driven By EMOTION

"My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry, because human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires." James 1:19-20

"For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline." 2 Timothy 1:7

# 3. Take Your Problems to the LORD

"Alarmed, Jehoshaphat resolved to inquire of the LORD, and he proclaimed a fast for all Judah."

#### 4. Admit You Need HELP

"Our God, will you not judge them? For we have no power to face this vast army that is attacking us. We do not know what to do, but our eyes are on you."

# 5. Rely On God's POWER

Did you notice that after Jehoshaphat admitted, "Lord, I don't know what to do," he added, "but our eyes are on You".



#### 6. Relax In FAITH

"Listen, King Jehoshaphat and all who live in Judah and Jerusalem! This is what the LORD says to you: 'Do not be afraid or discouraged because of this vast army. For the battle is not yours, but God's.'

#### "No, you didn't let Me down, because you weren't holding Me up."


#### We don't hold up God – He holds us up.
